

## GARNISH TABLE SET

Instructions and Fabric requirements are for one table runner and 4 placemats.  
 Fabric requirements for each project are on the following pages.

Please read all instructions before you begin. Seam allowance is 1/4".  
 Fabric is abbreviated as F and by number. For example, Fabric 1 is 'F1'.  
 Press seams in the direction of the arrows.

Print appliqué designs at 100%.  
 Appliqué designs are shown in reverse for use with Gentle Fuse fusible web.

WOF - Width of Fabric  
 LOF - Length of Fabric  
 RST - Right Sides Together  
 HST - Half Square Triangle

	F4	1 yard *includes binding	D Cut (10) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. From (2) cut: (32) 2-1/2" D squares Reserve (8) 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding Cut (1) 4" x WOF strip into: (4) 4" x 10-1/2" E rectangles Cut (1) 1-1/2" x WOF strip into: (4) 1-1/2" F squares  E F



	F1 10840-E	1/4 yard	A (6) 5" squares
	F2 10841-N	*1/4 yard	B (3) 5" squares *can use leftover placemat fabric
	F3 10843-R	*1/4 yard	C (3) 5" squares *can use leftover placemat fabric
	F4 10844-Q	5/8 yard *includes binding	D Cut (4) 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding. Cut (2) 2-1/2" x WOF strips into (24) 2-1/2" squares Cut (1) 4" x WOF strip into: (2) 4" x 10-1/2" rectangles (3) 1-1/2" squares  E F
	F5 10846-E	1/3 yard	G Cut (7) 1-1/2" x WOF strips From 2 strips cut (12) 1-1/2" x 5" rectangles From 2 strips cut (6) 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles Sew the remaining 3 strips together, end to end. Cut into (2) 43-1/2" top and bottom borders  H
	F6 10847-BQ	1/3 yard	K Cut (4) 2-1/2" x WOF strips From 1 strip cut (2) 16-1/2" side borders Sew 3 strips together and cut into: (2) 43-1/2" top and bottom borders  L
	BACKING	1-1/2 yards	Single piece along length of fabric.

**Garnish Placemats**

Repeat each step to make 4 blocks for the placemats.

Repeat each step to make 3 blocks for a table runner.

**Sashed Half Snowball Block**

1. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of (32) F4-D squares.

2. Place an F4-D square, RST over one corner of an F3-C square. Sew on the marked line. Cut  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the marked line. Press.

3. Repeat step 2, placing an F4-D square on the opposite corner. Make 4.



4. Top row: sew an F5-G rectangle to an F3 and F1 Half Snowball unit as illustrated to the right.

Press. Make 4.

5. Bottom row: sew an F5-G rectangle to an F1 and F2 Half Snowball unit as illustrated to the right. Press. Make 4.


6. Make the sashing: sew an F5-G rectangle to either side of an F4-F square. Press. Make 4.

7. Finish the block: lay the sections out in three rows as illustrated to the right: top row - sashing - bottom row. Sew together. Press toward sashing. Make 4.




**Add the Borders**


1. Sew an F4-E rectangle to an F5-H rectangle. Press toward F5.
2. Sew the step 1 unit to the left side of a Sashed Half Snowball block. Press.
3. Sew an F5-H rectangle to either side of step 2. Press.
4. Sew an F5-I rectangle to the top and bottom of step 3. Press.
5. Sew an F6-K rectangle to the top and bottom of step 4. Press.
6. Sew the F6-L rectangles to the sides of step 5. Press.
7. Repeat steps 1-6 to make a total of 4 placemats.







**Finishing**

1. Add the appliquéd to the placemats.  
\*Find the appliquéd templates pages 8-9 and the Gentle Fuse instructions on page 11.
2. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting and placemat top (right side up). Baste layers to secure. Quilt as desired. Trim the excess backing and batting.

3. Sew the binding strips together into one continuous strip. Press in half length-wise. Sew the binding to the placemat top with a 1/4" seam allowance. Turn the binding to the back side and stitch down by hand with matching thread.

Instructions make 1 table runner

1. Follow the instructions on page 4 to make 3 Sashed Half Snowball Blocks.


\*Note you will make 3 blocks for the runner. The instructions for the placemats are for 4 blocks.

2. Sew an F5-H rectangle to either side of an F4-E rectangle. Make 2.


3. Lay the remaining F5-H rectangles, Step 2 units, and sashed half snowball blocks out as illustrated below. Sew together. Press.




## Garnish Table Runner

Instructions make 1 table runner

4. Sew the F5-J borders to the top and bottom of the runner. Press.
5. Sew the F6-L borders to the top and bottom of the runner. Press. Sew the F6-K borders to the sides of the runner. Press.
6. Follow the instructions to add the appliqu  and finish the runner on p.6.






Placemats: Cut 4 large F7 circles and 4 small F5 circles.



Runner: Cut 2 large and 2 small circles.


Layer as illustrated.




Placemats: Cut 16 leaf pairs - 4 for each placemat.

Runner: Cut 8 leaf pairs






Flower appliqu  layout. Measures approximately 3" x 9".



Placemats: Cut 4 large F5 circles.  
Runner: Cut 2 large F5 circles



Placemats: Cut 4 large F7 flowers.  
Runner: Cut 2 large F7 flowers.



Make 1 center flower per motif. Measures approximately 3" x 3"

## Planning Diagram



## INSTRUCTIONS

### 1. DRAW

TRACE YOUR DESIGN ONTO THE PAPER SIDE OF GENTLE FUSE. LEAVE AT LEAST  $\frac{1}{2}$ " OF SPACE AROUND THE SHAPE AND CUT OUT.



### 2. FUSE

PRE-HEAT IRON TO A COTTON, NO STEAM SETTING & PLACE GENTLE FUSE ON THE WRONG SIDE OF FABRIC. USING IRON, PRESS FIRMLY FOR 5-8 SECONDS. CUT OUT THE DESIGN & PEEL AWAY THE PAPER BACKING. NEXT, POSITION THE PRE-FUSED APPLIQUÉ ON THE RIGHT SIDE OF FABRIC. IRON & PRESS FIRMLY FOR 8-10 SECONDS.



### 3. FINISH

FINISH WITH PREFERRED STITCH.

### FOR BEST RESULTS

PRE-WASH FABRIC • AVOID FABRIC SOFTENER • USE AN IRON  
TEST A SWATCH FIRST • DRAW DESIGNS IN REVERSE  
STORE AWAY FROM SUNLIGHT
