Fabric Requirements

Fabric 1	10854-W	Fat Quarter
Fabric 2	10852-J	Fat Quarter
Fabric 3	10855-J	Fat Quarter
Fabric 4	10854-O	Fat Quarter
Fabric 5	10853-K	Fat Quarter
Fabric 6	10854-K	Fat Quarter
Fabric 7	10853-O	Fat Quarter
Fabric 8	10855-K	Fat Quarter
Fabric 9	10856-J *Includes binding	1/2 yard
Fabric 10	10856-O2	Fat Quarter
Fabric 11	10856-O	Fat Quarter
Fabric 12	10856-W	1/8 yard
Backing	10851-J	3/4 yard
Gentle Fuse	Paper-backed fusible web	1/3 yard

*Backing: Cut the backing in half along the length of the fabric and sew the short ends together. Trim to measure approximately 21" x 54"



Cutting

Finished: 16-1/2" x 49-1/2"

Background: F1, F2, F3

From each fabric, cut:

- A: (1) 9-1/2" square
- B: (2) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles
- C: (1) 6-1/2" square
- D: (4) 2" squares

Upper Wing: F3, F4, F5

From each fabric, cut:

- E: (2) 5" x 8" rectangles
- F: (2) 2" x 3-1/2" rectangles

Lower Wing: F6, F7, F8

From each fabric, cut:

- G: (2) 2" x 6-1/2" rectangles
- H: (2) 2" x 3-1/2" rectangles
- I: (2) 2" squares
- J: (2) 3-1/2" squares

Center: F12

Cut:

- K: (3) 2" squares

Binding: F9

Cut (4) 2-1/4" x WOF strips

Bats: F9, F10, F11

From each fabric, cut:

- L: (1) 4-1/2" x 10" rectangle
- Gentle Fuse
- Cut: (3) 4-1/2" x 10" rectangles

Gentle Fuse

Cut: (3) 4-1/2" x 10" rectangles

WOF - Width of Fabric
LOF - Length of Fabric
RST - Right Sides Together
HST - Half Square Triangle

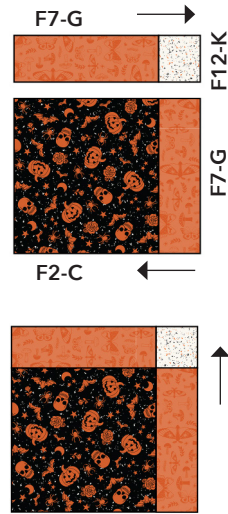
Goth Moths Table Runner Instructions

Please read all instructions before you begin. Seam allowance is 1/4". Press according to the arrows. Fabric is abbreviated as 'F' and by number. For example, Fabric 1 is 'F1'.

Sew the Blocks

Bottom Background Section

1. Sew (1) F7-G rectangle to (1) F12-K square. Press.
2. Sew (1) F2-C square to (1) F7-G rectangle. Press.
3. Sew step 1 and step 2 together as shown. Press.

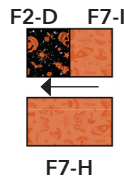

Wing Sections: Left and Right Wings

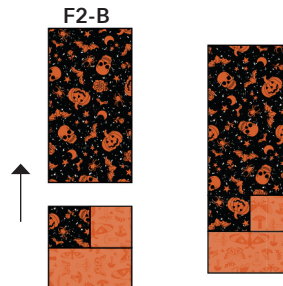
Left Wing:

4. Sew (1) F2-D square to the left side of (1) F7-I square. Press.
5. Sew (1) F7-H rectangle to the bottom of step 4. Press.
6. Sew (1) F2-B rectangle to the top of the step 5 unit. Press.

3-1/2" x 9-1/2"

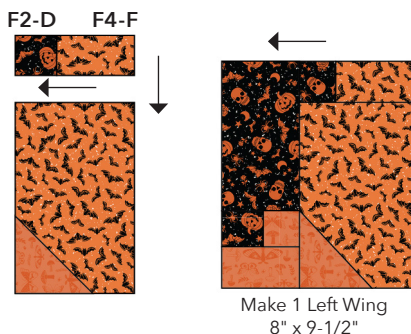
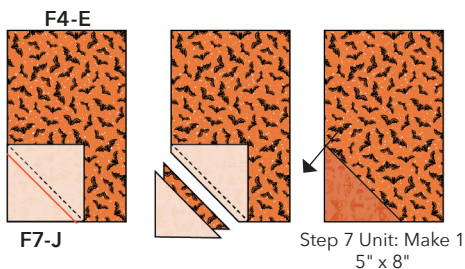
Left Wing Continued:

7. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the F7-J square. Place this square, RST, on the bottom left corner of (1) F4-E rectangle. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the stitched line, press.

8. Sew (1) F2-D square to the left side of (1) F4-F rectangle. Press.

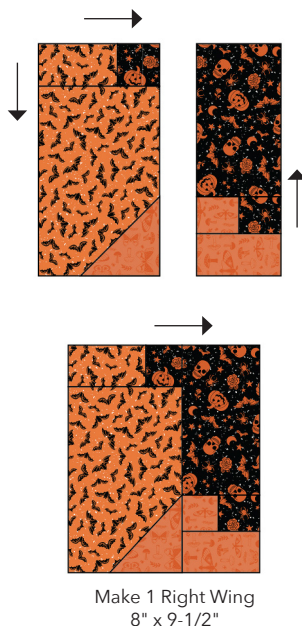
9. Sew the step 8 unit to the top of the step 7 unit. Press.

10. Sew the step 6 unit to the left side of the step 9 unit. Press. The Left Wing unit should measure 8" W x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " tall.



Right Wing:

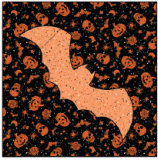
11. Repeat Steps 4-10, switching the placement of the fabrics to create a mirror image of the Left Wing unit. The Right Wing unit should measure 8" W x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " tall.



Top Background Appliqué Section

12. Trace the Bat Template on the paper side of the 4-½" x 10" rectangle of the fusible webbing. Press the fusible side to the wrong side of the F10-L rectangle. Cut out the bat on the line.

13. Place the F10 bat on the F2-A square, as shown. Remove the backing and fuse in place. Stitch in place.

Assemble the Goth Moth Block

14. Lay out the Bottom background section, Left Wing section, Right Wing section (rotated 90 degrees), and the Top background appliqué section.

15. Sew the Left Wing section to the Bottom background section. Press.

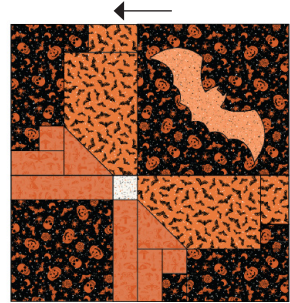
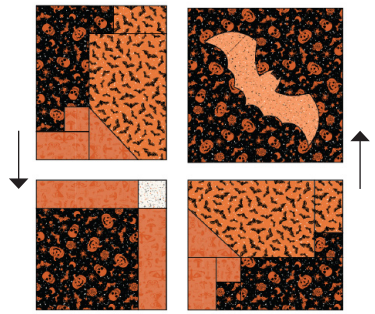
16. Sew the Top background appliqué section to the Right Wing section. Press

17. Sew step 15 to step 16. Press. The Orange Goth Moth Block should measure 17" square.

18. Repeat Steps 1-17 to make 2 more Goth Moth blocks.

White Moth uses: F1, F3, F6, F9, and F12

Black Moth uses: F3, F5, F8, F11, and F12



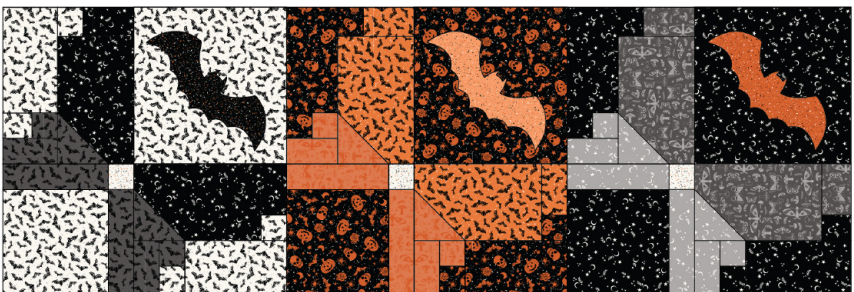

Assemble the Goth Moths Runner

19. Lay out the Goth Moth blocks as shown. Sew them together. Press in one direction. The runner should measure 17" x 50".

20. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting and tablerunner top (right side up). Baste layers to secure. Quilt as desired. Trim the excess backing and batting.

21. Sew the binding strips together into one continuous strip. Press in half length-wise. Sew the binding to the front of the runner with a 1/4" seam allowance. Turn the binding to the back side of the runner and stitch down by hand with matching thread.
