

Directional Fabrics

Pay attention to the directional fabrics when cutting the rectangles for the flying geese. The strips are cut at 3-1/2" x WOF and you will sub-cut these into 3-1/2" by 6-1/2" rectangles.

Cutting

48" x 60"

Fabric 1 Background

Cut (5) 4" x WOF strips into
A (46) 4" x 4" squares for HSTs
 Cut (6) 3-1/2" x WOF strips into
B (62) 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" squares
C (10) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles
 Cut (4) 6-1/2" strips into
D (18) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles
E (4) 6-1/2" x 6-1/2" squares
F (4) 6-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangles

Fabric 2

Cut (2) 4" x WOF strips into
G (14) 4" x 4" squares
H (5) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles

Fabric 3

Cut (4) 4" x WOF strips into
I (32) 4" x 4" squares
 Cut (4) 3-1/2" x WOF strips into
J (48) 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" squares. You will get
 44 from the 4 strips. Cut 4 more from the
 leftover 4" strip.

Fabrics 4, 5, 6

Cut (1) 3-1/2" x WOF strips into
K (5) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles

Fabric 6

Cut (4) 3-1/2" x WOF strips into
M (32) 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" squares

Fabric 7

Cut (4) 3-1/2" x WOF strips into
N (24) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles

Binding

Cut (6) 2-1/4" x WOF strips.

Fabric 8

Cut (4) 3-1/2" x WOF strips into
O (24) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles

*Note: there is no 'L' unit. It skips from K to M.

WOF - Width of Fabric

LOF - Length of Fabric

RST - Right Sides Together

HST - Half Square Triangle

Homemade Holidays Quilt Instructions

Please read all instructions before you begin. Seam allowance is 1/4". Fabric is abbreviated as 'F' and by number. For example, Fabric 1 is 'F1'.


Make 2-at-a-time HST Units (Half Square Triangles)

Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of the F1-A squares.


Place an F1-A square and an F2-G square, RST (right sides together) and sew 1/4" away from either side of the marked line.

Cut on the marked line. Press away from F1. Make 14 pairs for 28 HSTs. Trim to 3-1/2" x 3-1/2".

Repeat the steps above with the remaining 32 F1-A and F3-I squares for a total of 32 pairs and 64 HSTs.


Make the Flying Geese Units

Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 46 F1-B squares.


Place an F1-B square, RST, on the left side of an F4-K rectangle and sew on the marked line. Trim 1/4" away from the stitched line. Press.

Place an F1-B square, RST, on the right side of the same unit. Stitch on the marked line. Trim 1/4" away from the stitched line. Press.


Repeat the steps above to make the flying geese units illustrated to the right.



Side Triangles

Arrange an F1/F3 HST unit on either side of an F8/F3 flying geese unit as illustrated to the right. Sew together and press. Make 24.


Triangle Block

Arrange an F1-B square on either side of an F1/F7 flying geese unit as illustrated to the right. Sew together and press. Make 4.

Sew to a triangle row to a Side Triangle unit from the previous step. Press. Make 4.

Partial Triangle Sections

Place an F1-D rectangle, RST, over an F1/F7 flying geese unit as illustrated to the right. Sew together and press.

Place two F1/F3 HST units, RST, as illustrated to the right. Sew together and press. Make 8 HST Pairs. *4 are used for the rows shown on p.9

Sew 2 HST sections to the right side of 2 Geese/Rectangle sections. Press. Make 2.

Sew 2 HST sections to the left side of 2 Geese/Rectangle sections. Press. Make 2.

Double Triangle Block

Arrange four F7/F6 flying geese units into three rows as illustrated to the right.

Sew the center geese units together and press.

Sew the rows together to make the center triangle section. Make 4.

Sew a triangle row to either side of the center triangles section from the previous step. Press. Make 4.



Tree Block

Sew an F5/F1 flying geese unit on top of an F6/F1 flying geese unit. Press. Make 5.

Arrange the following units into three rows as illustrated to the right:

Row 1:

F1/F2 HST - F4/F1 Flying Geese Unit - F1/F2 HST.

Row 2:

F1-D rectangle - F5/F1-F6/F1 Flying Geese Unit - F1D


Row 3:

F1/F2 HST - F1C - F2H - F1C - F1/F2 HST


Sew together into three rows and press.

Sew row to row and press.

Make 5.



Tree Block Rows




Tree Block

12-1/2" x 12-1/2"

Partial Tree Block

Place an F1/F2 HST over an F1-B square, RST and sew. Press. Make 4.

Repeat the previous step with the HST facing the opposite direction to make 4 more mirror image units.

Sew an F1/F2 HST/F1-B unit to either side of an F1-E square as illustrated to the right and press. Make 4.

Double Tree Row 3

Lay the blocks out as illustrated below. Sew into a row and press. Make 2.





Top Assembly

Lay out the quilt blocks as illustrated below. Sew blocks into rows and press. Sew rows together and press.



Finishing

Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting and quilt top (right side up). Baste layers to secure. Quilt as desired. Trim the excess backing and batting.

Sew the binding strips together into one continuous strip. Press in half length-wise. Sew the binding to the quilt top with a 1/4" seam allowance. Turn the binding to the back side of the quilt and stitch down by hand with matching thread.
