## Fabric Requirements

Fabric 2	MAS10931-B	1 yard
Fabric 3	MAS10937-E	1/3 yard
Fabric 4	MAS10938-E	1 1/4 yards
Fabric 5	MAS10934-T	7/8 yard
Fabric 6	MAS10938-B	3/4 yard
Fabric 7	MAS10932-T	3/4 yard
Fabric 8	MAS10938-B Binding	1/2 yard
	Backing	4 1/2 yards

## Cutting

Finished: 54" x 70"

Fabric 1

Cut (6) 3" x WOF strips into:  
(84) A 3" squares

Fabric 2

Cut (4) 3" x WOF strips into:  
(48) B 3" squares

Cut (9) 2-1/2" x WOF strips into:

(48) C 2-1/2" squares  
(12) D 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles  
(24) E 2-1/2" squares  
(24) F 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles

Fabric 3

Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip into:  
(6) B 3" squares

Cut (3) 2-1/2" x WOF strips into:

(12) E 2-1/2" squares  
(12) F 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles

Fabric 4

Cut (6) 3" x WOF strips into:  
(84) A 3" squares

Cut (6) 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end to end, and cut into:

(2) 3-1/2" x 64-1/2" strips for side borders

(2) 3-1/2" x 54-1/2" strips for top and bottom borders

Fabric 5

Cut (3) 3" x WOF strips into:  
(42) B 3" squares

Cut (7) 2-1/2" x WOF strips into:

(48) C 2-1/2" squares  
(12) D 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles  
(12) E 2-1/2" squares  
(12) F 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles

Fabrics 6 & 7


Cut (3) 3" x WOF strips of each fabric into:  
(36) B 3" squares

Cut (5) 2-1/2" x WOF strips from each fabric into:

(48) C 2-1/2" squares  
(12) D 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles

Fabric 8

Cut (7) 2-1/4" x WOF strips for binding



Block Diagram

WOF - Width of Fabric

LOF - Length of Fabric

RST - Right Sides Together

HST - Half Square Triangle


## True North Quilt Instructions

Please read all instructions before you begin. Seam allowance is 1/4". Press according to the arrows. Fabric is abbreviated as 'F' and by number. For example, Fabric 1 is 'F1'.


### HSTs - Half Square Triangles

2-at-a-Time

1. Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the F1-A squares.




2. Place an F1-A square, right sides facing, over an F2-B square. Sew 1/4" away from the marked line on each side.



3. Cut into two pieces on the marked line. Press toward F2 and trim to 2-1/2" square.


Fabric 2 HSTs  
Make 72  
2-1/2" x 2-1/2"

4. Repeat to make a total of 36 pairs for 72 HSTs.




Fabric 3 HSTs  
Make 12  
2-1/2" x 2-1/2"

5. Repeat steps 1-4 to make a total of 6 pairs for 12 HSTs using the F3-B squares.

6. Repeat steps 1-5 with the other fabric combinations, illustrated to the right.

### Make the Units

A, B, C, and D Units

1. Lay the HSTs, squares, and rectangles out in rows as illustrated to the right:

Row 1: C-HST-HST-C

Row 2: HST-F-HST

Row 3: HST-E-D

Row 4: C-HST-C-HST



F2C - F2HST - F2HST - F2C



F2HST - F3F - F2HST



F2C - F3HST - F2C - F3HST

2. Sew into rows. Press to nest.



F2C - F2HST - F2C - F3HST

3. Sew row to row. Press.  
Make (12) A Units.






4. Repeat steps 1-3 following the illustration to the right to make (12) each of the B, C and D units.



## Sew the Blocks

1. Lay the A units out as illustrated to the right.
2. Sew into rows. Press to nest.
3. Sew row to row. Press open. Make (3) A Blocks.
4. Repeat to make (3) B, C, and D blocks as illustrated below.



## Top, Borders, & Finishing

1. Sew the blocks together into rows as illustrated below. Press open.
2. Sew the side borders to the quilt top. Press toward the borders. Then sew the top and bottom borders to the quilt top. Press toward the borders.



3. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting, and tablerunner top (right side up). Baste layers to secure. Quilt as desired. Trim the excess backing and batting.
4. Sew the binding strips together into one continuous strip. Press in half length-wise. Sew the binding to the front of the runner with a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Turn the binding to the back side of the runner and stitch down by hand with matching thread.
