

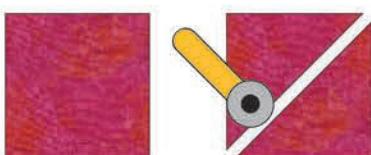

Before you begin.

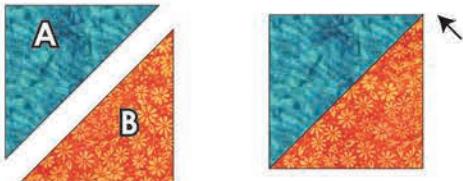
Cut the 8 $\frac{1}{8}$ " squares from fabric groups A-E. Cut each square once on the diagonal to create two triangles. Set triangles aside, keeping them separated in fabric groups A-E. Fabric groups are shown on page 3.

Assemble the HST (Half-Square-Triangle) Units.

HST units measure 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (8" finished). Use a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Press in the direction of the arrows.

Step 1: HST Unit 1 (A-B)

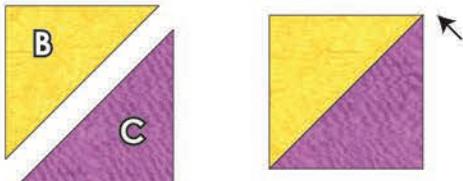
Pair A and B triangles RST (Right-sides together) using different prints to create variety. Sew along the diagonal edge. Press.



Make 11 units from a variety of A-B fabrics.

Step 2: HST Unit 2 (B-C)

Pair B and C triangles RST using different prints. Sew along the diagonal edge. Press.



Make 11 units from a variety of B-C fabrics.

Step 3: HST Unit 3 (C-D)

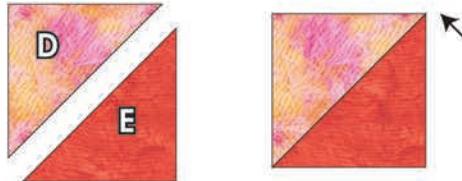
Pair C and D triangles RST using different prints. Sew along the diagonal edge. Press.



Make 11 units from a variety of C-D fabrics.

Step 4: HST Unit 4 (D-E)

Pair D and E triangles RST using different prints. Sew along the diagonal edge. Press.



Make 11 units from a variety of D-E units.

Step 5: HST Unit 5 (E-A)

Pair E and A triangles RST using different prints. Sew along the diagonal edge. Press.



Make 10 units from a variety of E-A units.

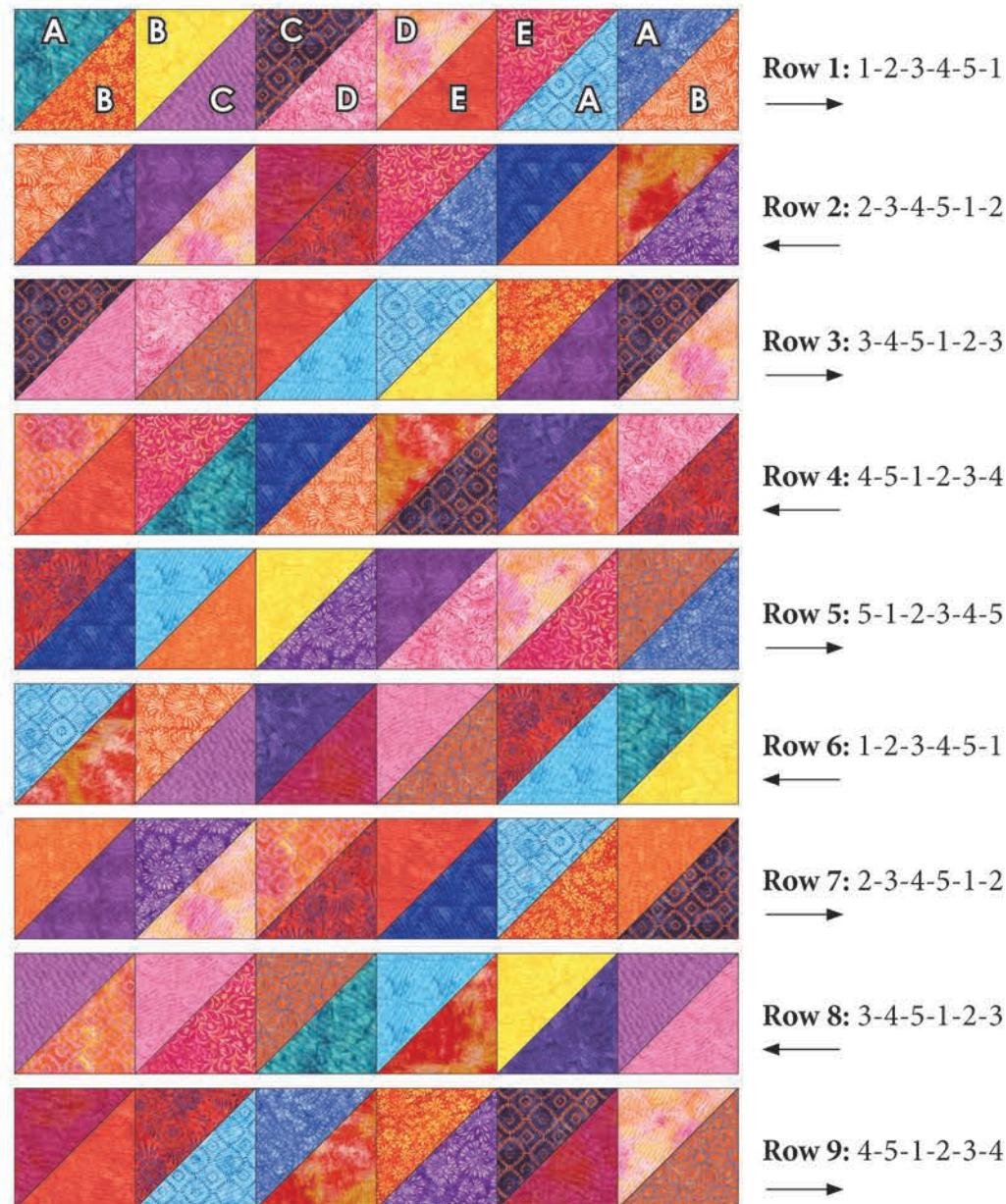
Note: you will have 6 triangles left over.

Tip: The fabrics in your HST Units may vary depending on how you pair them in steps 1-5. The way the pairs are arranged into the rows create the fun diagonal look in the final layout. There are many possible combinations! Follow our example or create your own.

Step 6: Assemble the rows. Arrange the HST units in the order shown next to each row. Press in the direction of arrows. Sew the units together to form nine rows of six blocks.

HST Units are referred to by numbers:

1 (A-B), 2 (B-C), 3 (C-D), 4 (D-E), 5 (E-A)



Step 7: Assemble the quilt top. Sew row-to-row and press seams open.

Step 8: Finish the quilt. Make a quilt sandwich: layer the backing (wrong side up), batting and quilt (right side up). Baste layers together and quilt as desired. Finish the quilt with a double-fold binding.
