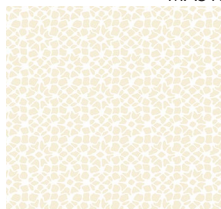

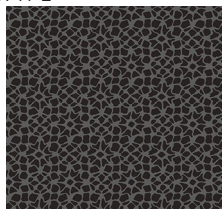

Fabric 5	MAS10944-E	1/4 yard
Fabric 6	MAS10945-J	1/3 yard
*Backing		1 yard

Cutting

Finished: 15" x 45"

Fabric 1

Fussy cut 3 sets of (4) 5-½" squares (As illustrated on page 4)

F1-A pink
F1-A blue
F1-A green

Fabric 2

Fussy cut 3 sets of (4) 3" squares (As illustrated on page 4)

F2-B pink
F2-B blue
F2-B green

Fabric 3

Cut (1) 3-½" x WOF strip. Subcut into:
C: (12) 3-½" squares

Fabric 4

Cut (1) 3-½" x WOF strip. Subcut into:
D: (12) 3-½" squares

Fabric 5

Cut (2) 3" x WOF strips. Subcut into:
E: (24) 3" squares

Fabric 6

Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip. Subcut into:
F: (12) 3" squares
Cut (3) 2-¼" x WOF strips for binding

WOF - Width of Fabric
LOF - Length of Fabric
RST - Right Sides Together
HST - Half Square Triangle

Due South Runner Instructions

Please read all instructions before you begin. Seam allowance is 1/4". Press according to the arrows. Fabric is abbreviated as 'F' and by number. For example, Fabric 1 is 'F1'.

Fussy cut 3 sets of four 5-1/2" squares.

F1-A blue
F1-A green

Sew the Blocks

1. Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of all the F3-C 3-½" squares. Place an F3-C square right sides together, over an F4-D square. Sew ¼" away from either side of the marked line. Cut apart on the marked line. Press. Trim to 3" square. Make a total of 24 HSTs.

2. Sew an F5-E square to the left side of an HST, following the illustration to the right. Press. Repeat to make a total of 12.

3. Sew an F5-E square to the right side of an HST, following the illustration to the right. Press. Repeat to make a total of 12.

4. Sew an F2-B (pink) square to the right side of a step 3 unit. Press. Repeat to make a total of 4.

5. Repeat Step 4 with the F2-B (blue) squares.

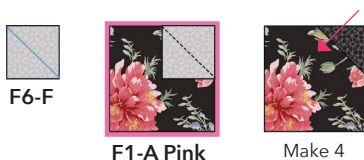
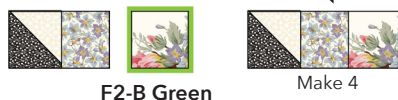
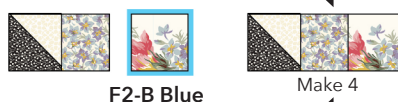
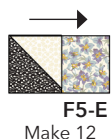
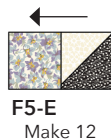
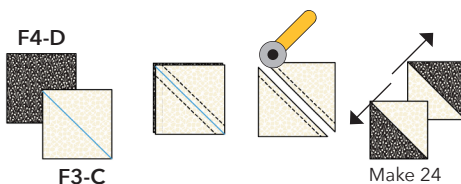
6. Repeat Step 4 with the F2-B (green) squares.

7. Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of all the F6-F 3" squares.

8. Place an F6-F square right sides together, over an F1-A (pink) square, in the top right corner. Pay attention to the direction of the drawn line. Sew on the line. Trim ¼" away from the marked line. Press. Repeat to make a total of 4.

9. Repeat Step 8 with the F1-A (blue) squares.

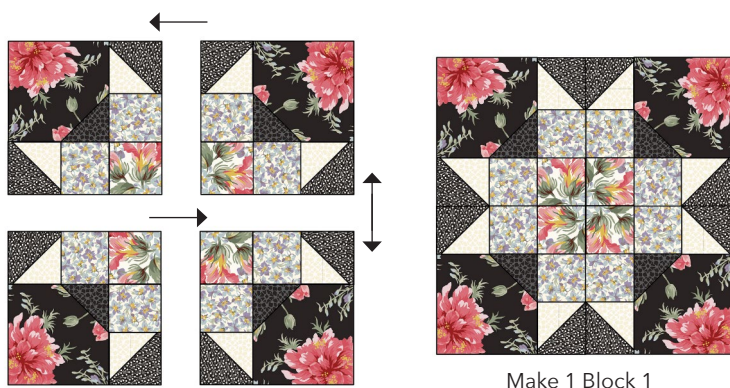
10. Repeat Step 8 with the F1-A (green) squares.



11. Sew a Step 2 unit to the right side of a Step 8 unit. Press. Repeat to make 4.

12. Sew a Step 4 unit to the bottom of a step 11 unit. Press. Repeat to make 4.

13. Lay out all (4) Step 12 units as illustrated below. Sew units into rows. Press, Sew top and bottom row together to make a block.



14. Repeat steps 11-13 using the units from steps 9 and 10 to make the remaining two blocks as illustrated below. Make 1 of each.

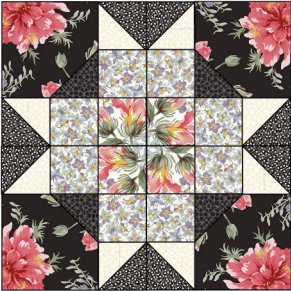


Assemble the Due South Runner

Lay out the Due South blocks as shown. Sew them together. Press in one direction.

Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting and runner top (right side up). Baste layers to secure. Quilt as desired. Trim the excess backing and batting.

Sew the binding strips together into one continuous strip. Press in half length-wise. Sew the binding to the front of the runner with a ¼" seam allowance. Turn the binding to the back side of the runner and stitch down by hand with matching thread.

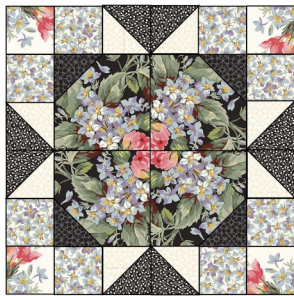
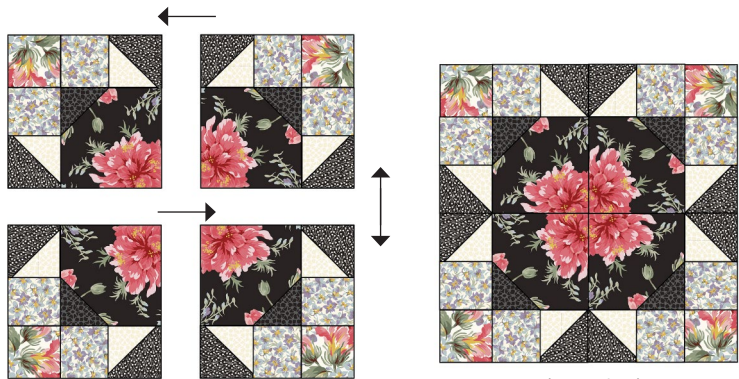

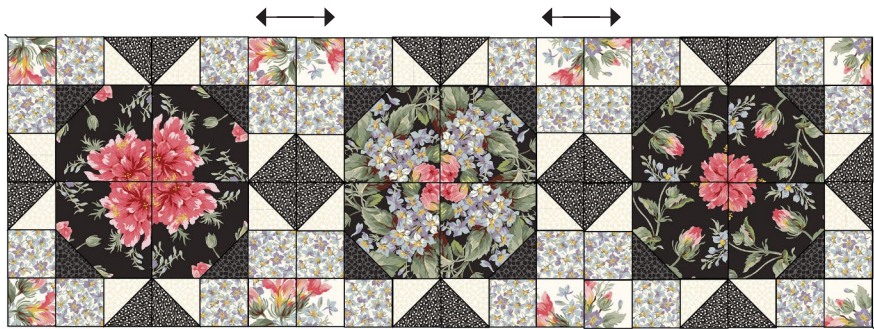
Version 2
