| | D Cut (2) 4-3/4" x WOF strips |
| Fabric 3 | E Cut (4) 2" x WOF strips |
| | Cut (1) 4-1/2" x WOF strip into: F (20) 2" x 4-1/2" rectangles |
| | Cut (1) 7-1/2" x WOF strip into: G (20) 2" x 7-1/2" rectangles |
| Sashing/Inner Borders | |
| | Cut (1) 10-1/2" x WOF strip into: J (15) 2" x 10-1/2" rectangles |
| | Cut (11) 2" x WOF strips |
| | Sew together (5) strips. Cut into: (4) 2" x 45" strips |
| | Sew together (3) strips. Cut into: (2) 2" x 56-1/2" inner side borders |
| | Sew together (3) strips. Cut into: (2) 2" x 48" inner top and bottom borders |
| Fabric 4 | |
| | Cut (2) 7-1/2" x WOF strips into: H (10) 7-1/2" x 7-1/2" squares |
| Fabric 5 | |
| | Cut (2) 4-1/2" x WOF strips into: I (10) 4-1/2" x 4-1/2" squares |
| Fabric 6 | |
| | Cut (6) 5" x WOF strips. Sew together end to end and cut into: (2) 5" x 59-1/2" outer side borders (2) 5" x 57" outer top and bottom borders |
| Fabric 7 | |
| | Cut (7) 2-1/4" x WOF strips for binding. |

Out West Quilt Instructions



Please read all instructions before you begin. Seam allowance is 1/4". Fabric is abbreviated as 'F' - for example, F1 refers to Fabric 1. Press in the direction of the arrows.

Strip Sets (SST)

1. Sew the strip sets together as illustrated to the right.




2. Cut each into (20) 2" pieces.





A Blocks

1. Sew an SST-1 to either side of an F4-H square. Press.
2. Sew an SST-2 to the top and bottom of the Step 1 unit. Press.
3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make 10 A blocks.




B Blocks

1. Sew an F3-F rectangle to opposite sides of an F5-I square. Press.
2. Sew an F3-G rectangle to the top and bottom of the Step 1 unit. Press.
3. Sew an SST-3 to either side of the Step 2 unit. Press.
4. Sew an SST-4 to the top and bottom of the Step 3 unit. Press.
5. Repeat Steps 1-4 to make 10 B blocks.



Rows

1. Sew the blocks and the F3-J rectangles into rows as illustrated below. Press. Repeat to make (3) Row 1s and (2) Row 2s.







Borders


Illustrations on p.7

2. Sew the F3 inner side borders to the quilt top. Press. Sew the F3 inner top and bottom borders to the quilt top. Press.


3. Sew the F6 outer side borders to the quilt top. Press. Sew the F6 outer top and bottom borders to the quilt top. Press.

Tip: Pin the borders to the quilt top starting at the center and pinning out to the edge for each round. This will help to make sure you don't stretch the borders as you sew.

Finishing

1. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste layers to secure. Quilt as desired. Trim the excess backing and batting.
2. Sew the binding strips together into one continuous strip. Press in half length-wise. Sew the binding to the quilt top with a 1/4" seam allowance. Turn the binding to the back side of the quilt and stitch down by hand with matching thread.
