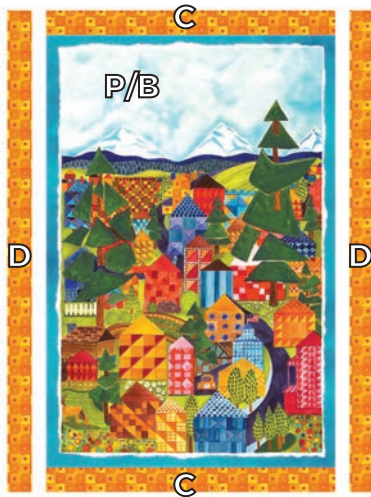

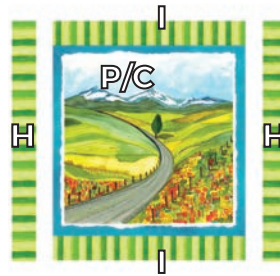
Please read all instructions before you begin. Seam allowance is 1/4" unless otherwise stated. Use a light sizing/starch on the squares before cutting triangles to help control stretching along the bias edges.

1. Mark and fussy cut each of the sections of the Quiltlandia fabric panel.



14-1/2" x 20-1/2"

2. Sew the (Fabric 2) C strips to the top and bottom of the P/B panel section. Press away from center. Sew the (Fabric 2) D strips to the either side of the P/B panel section. Press away from the center.



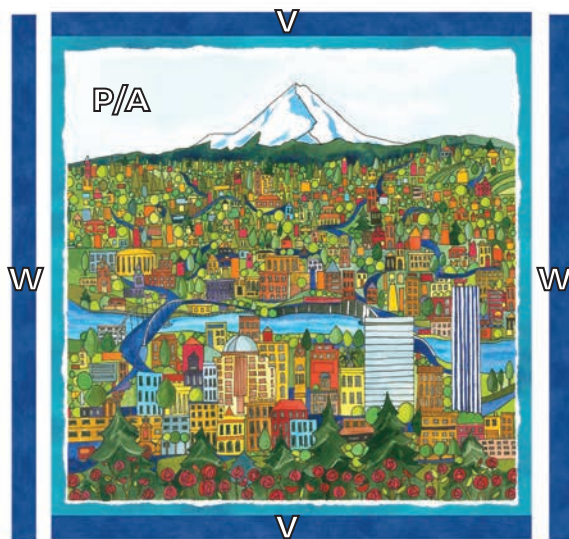
10-1/2" x 10-1/2"

3. Sew the (Fabric 3) I strips to the top and bottom of the P/C panel section. Press away from center. Sew the (Fabric 3) H strips to either side of the P/C panel section. Press away from center.



10-1/2" x 10-1/2"

4. Sew the (Fabric 5) M strips to the top and bottom of the P/D panel section. Press away from center. Sew the (Fabric 5) N strips to either side of the P/D panel section. Press away from center.



22-1/2" x 22-1/2"

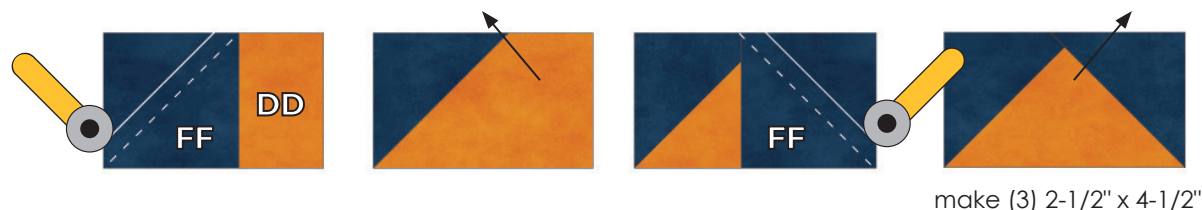
5. Sew the (Fabric 9) V strips to the top and bottom of the P/A panel section. Press away from center. Sew the (Fabric 9) W strips to either side of the P/A panel section. Press away from center.



26-1/2" x 26-1/2"

6. Sew the (Fabric 9) A strips to the top and bottom of the step 5 unit. Press away from center. Sew the (Fabric 1) B strips to the sides to complete the section. Press away from center.

7. Sew the Flying Geese: Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 6 (Fabric 12) FF squares. Place a (Fabric 12) FF square over a (Fabric 11) DD rectangle right sides together (RST). Stitch on the marked line. Trim 1/4" away from the stitch line and press.

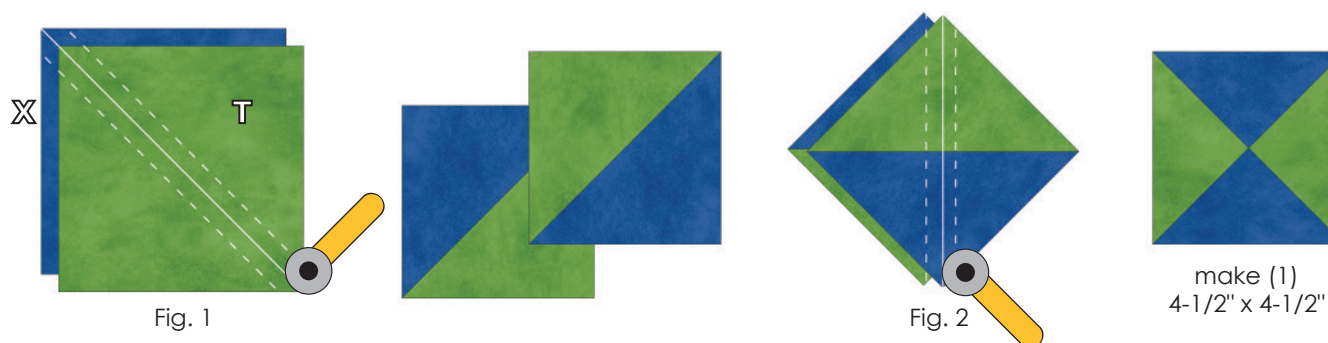


8. Place a (Fabric 12) FF square on the opposite side of the step 7 unit. Trim 1/4" away from the stitch line and press. Make a total of (3) FF/DD flying geese.



9. Repeat steps 7-8 to make the flying geese units pictured above. Use the (Fabric 12) FF squares with each rectangle indicated. Units will finish at 2-1/2" x 4-1/2".

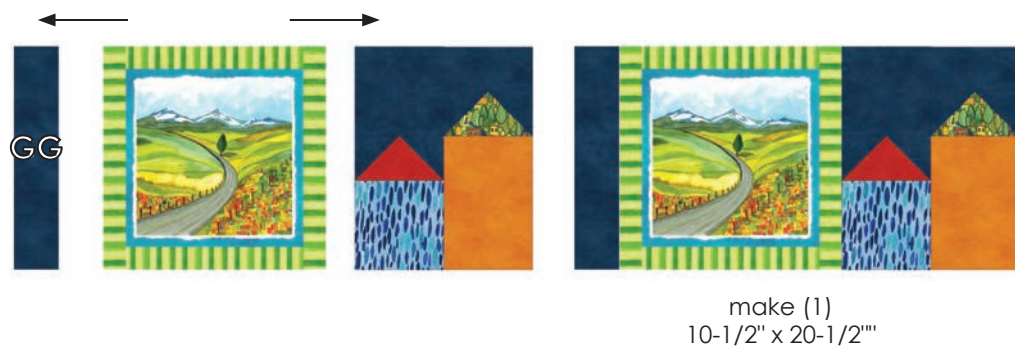
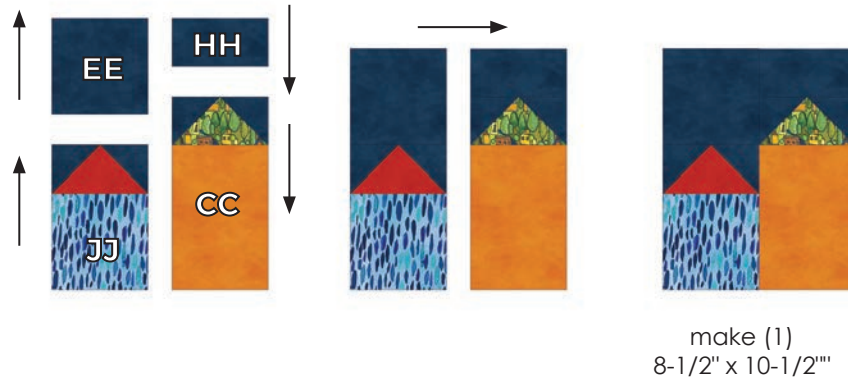
10. Sew the Hour Glass unit. Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the (fabric 8) T square. Place over the (fabric 9) X square, RST, and stitch 1/4" away from either side of the marked line. Cut on the marked line to make two half square triangle (HST) units (Fig 1). Press toward fabric 9. Mark a line from corner to corner on one of the HST units. Place the HST units, RST, and sew 1/4" away from either side of the marked line (Fig. 2). Cut on the marked line. You will have two hour glass units - you will only use one.



11. Make the Half Square Triangle: Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on a (fabric 7) P square and a (fabric 5) O square. Cut 1/4" away from the marked line. Sew the P and O triangles together (fig. 3). Press toward P.

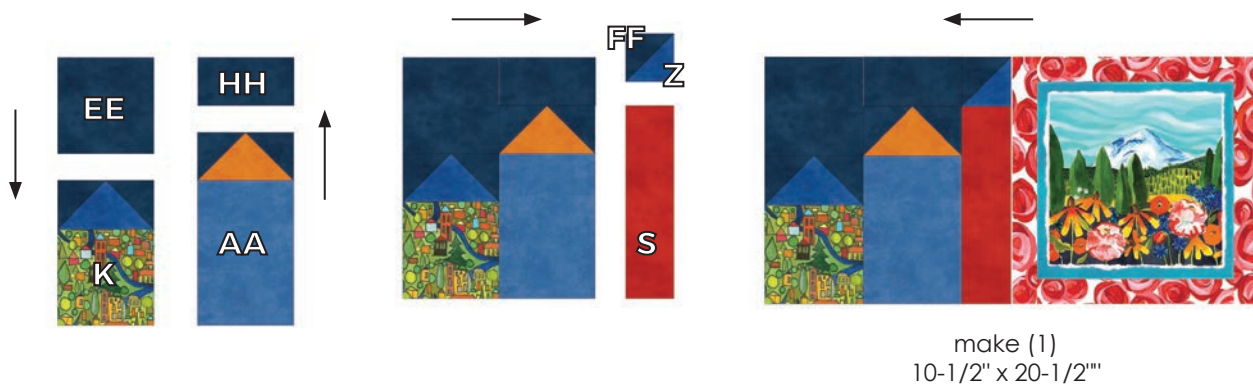


12. Sew the upper house sections as illustrated below using the flying geese from steps 7-8. Attach to the P/C panel section from step 3.



13. Sew the lower house sections together as illustrated below using the flying geese from steps 7-8 and the HST unit (fig 4). Attach to the P/D panel section from step 4.

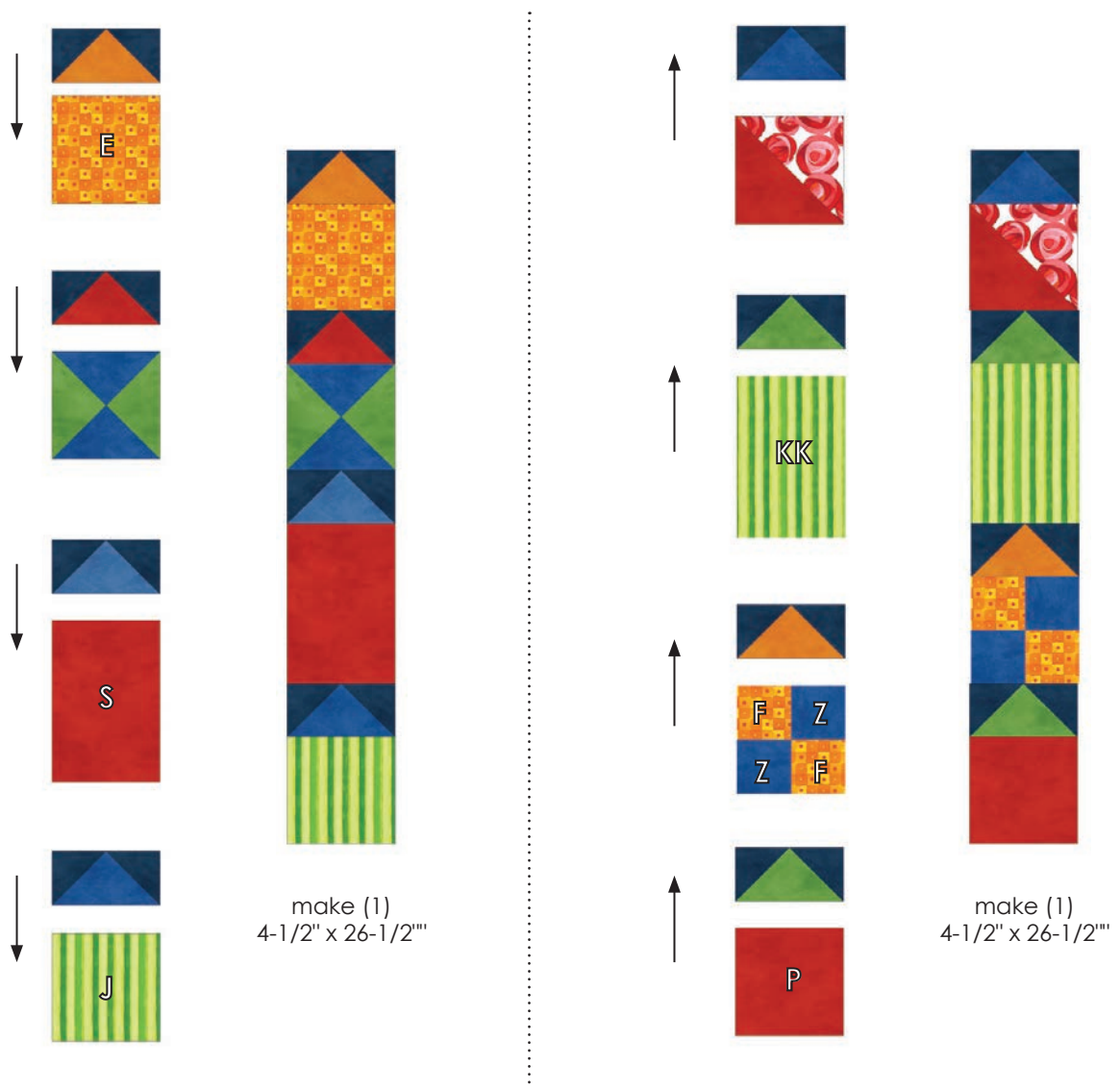
Follow step 11 to make the HST unit made with a (fabric 9) Z square and a (fabric 12) FF square.



14. Sew house sections together and then sew the P/B panel section from step 1 to the house unit from steps 12-13 as illustrated.



15. Sew the vertical house sections together as illustrated using the flying geese, step 10 hourglass unit, and step 11 HST unit.



14. Inner Borders: Measure the length of the quilt through the middle. Piece and trim two (Fabric 12) borders to this length. Sew to the sides of the quilt. Press toward the borders.

15. Measure the width of the quilt through the middle. Piece (if necessary) and trim two (Fabric 12) borders to this width. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press toward the borders.

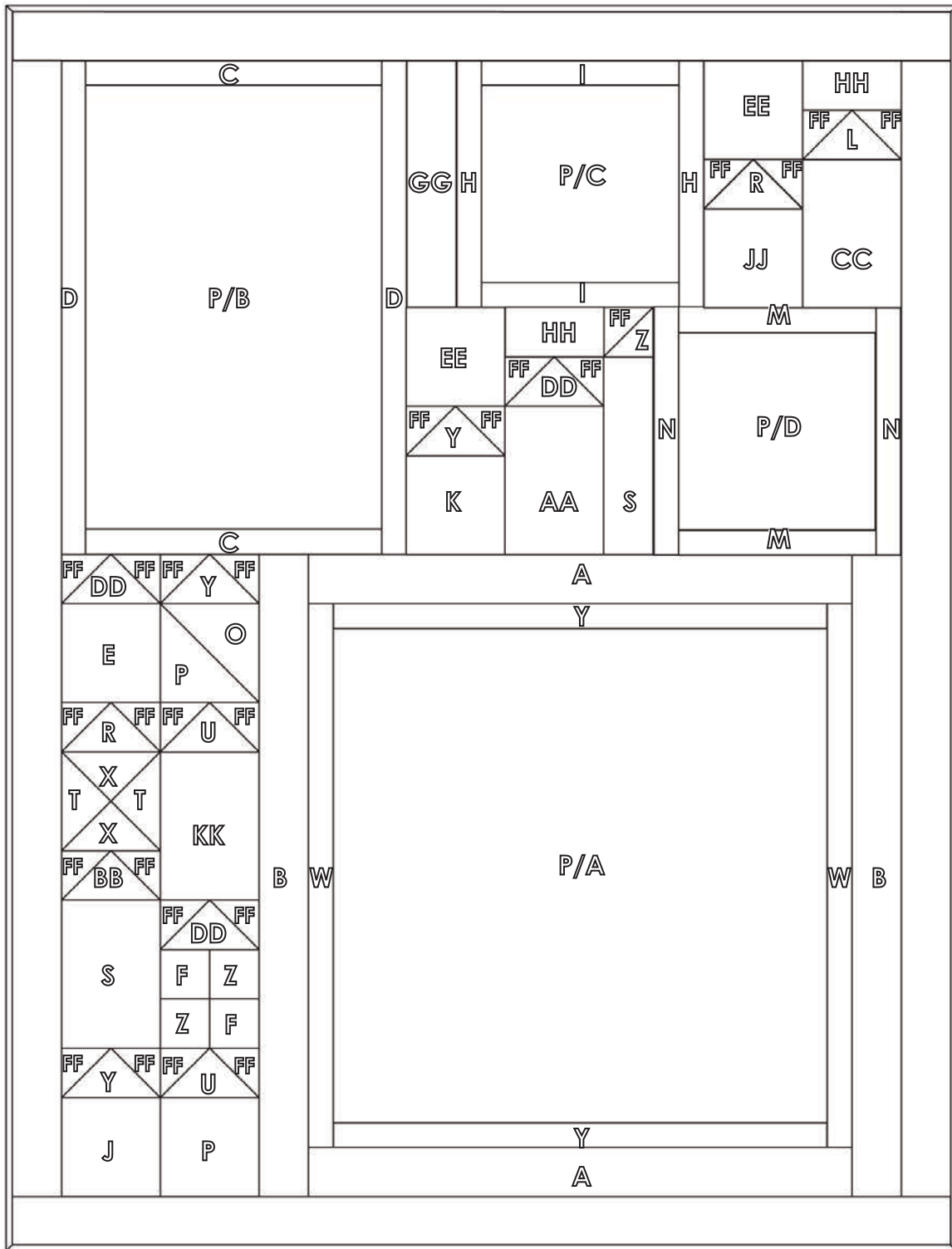


















16. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting and quilt top (right side up). Baste layers to secure. Quilt as desired.

17. Sew the binding strips together into one continuous strip. Press in half length-wise.

18. Sew the binding to the quilt top with a 3/8" seam allowance, mitering the corners. Trim the excess backing and batting, then turn the binding to the back side of the quilt and stitch down by hand with matching thread.
