

1½ yds




From Fabric 1, fussy-cut:
1 — 34½" x 48½" rectangle
of the center circle section (the larger circles). A bit of the green stripes
on each side may be included in this
rectangle, but should be kept inside
the seam allowance so it won't show
in the final quilt. Trim further if
necessary.



From Fabric 3, fussy-cut:
4 — 6½" x LOF (Length Of Fabric)
strips, centering the floral stripes as
shown below,
and
4 — 3½" x LOF strips,
cutting $\frac{1}{4}$ " beyond the red line as
shown (so that the red stripe is just
clear of the seam allowance).


From Fabric 2, cut:
4 — 3½" x squares
for the cornerstones
and
7 — 2½" x WOF (Width Of Fabric)
strips for binding

Backing
Flannel
3¾ yds

To make the backing piece, cut the
fabric in half crosswise (selvage
to selvage), remove the selvages,
and then sew the 2 pieces together
lengthwise (along the long edges).

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Inner Vine Border

**Before attaching vine borders, please see the quilt diagram. You'll notice that the leaves point to the right in the top border and to the left in the bottom border. On the left side border the leaves point up, and on the right side border they point down. Follow this layout for a vine border that appears to wind naturally all the way around the quilt.*

1. Measure the height (longer side) of your Fabric 1 rectangle. Trim two of the $6\frac{1}{2}$ " strips of Fabric 3 to match this length, making sure to center the floral motif at both ends. Sew to the sides of the quilt (*refer to diagram). Press seams open.
2. Measure the width of the quilt (including all attached borders) and trim the two remaining $6\frac{1}{2}$ " strips of Fabric 3 to this length, again centering the floral motif. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt*. Press seams open.

Outer Lamb's Ear Border

***Before attaching lamb's ear borders, make sure the red stripe faces in and the lamb's ears point out on all four sides (see diagram).*

3. Measure the height of the quilt (including all attached borders). Trim two $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strips of Fabric 3 to match this length, centering the lamb's ear motif. Sew to the sides of the quilt**. Press seams open.

4. Measure the width of the quilt (including all attached borders). Trim the two remaining $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strips of Fabric 3 to match this length, again centering the lamb's ear motif.

5. Sew a $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square of Fabric 2 to both ends of each remaining $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strip of Fabric 3. Press seams open. Sew these final borders to the top and bottom of the quilt**. Press seams open.

Finishing

6. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired.

7. To make the binding, sew the seven $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips of Fabric 2 together end-to-end with diagonal seams pressed open. Sew to the quilt using your favorite binding method.
