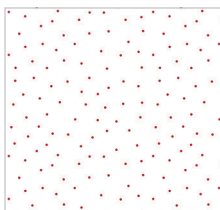

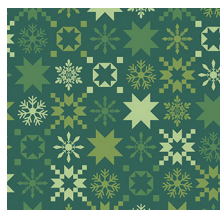

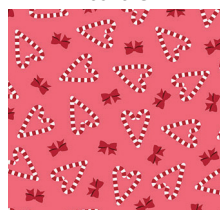

Fabric 2	10576-G	fat quarter
Fabric 3	10577-G	fat quarter
Fabric 4	10577-R	fat quarter
Fabric 5	10578-R	fat quarter plus 1/3 yard for binding
Backing	10574-W	1-1/2 yards

Cutting

Finished Size: 18" x 48"

Fabric 1 Background

Cut (1) 4-1/2" x WOF strip into:

- A (4) 4-1/2" squares
- B (4) 3-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles
- C (4) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles

Cut (1) 3" x WOF strip into:

- D (4) 3" squares
- E (2) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles
- F (4) 2-1/2" x 4-3/4" rectangles

Cut (1) 6-1/2" x WOF strip into:

- G (2) 4" x 6-1/2" rectangles
- H (1) 6-1/2" square
- I (4) 5-1/2" squares
- U (10) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle

Cut (3) 2" x WOF strips into:

- (2) 2" x 18-1/2" side sashing
- (2) 2" x 45-1/2" top/bottom sashing

Fabric 2 Light Green

From the fat quarter cut:

- J (2) 2" x 5-3/4" rectangles
- K (2) 6-1/4" x 8" rectangles

Fabric 3 Green

From the fat quarter cut:

- L (2) 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles
- M (2) 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles
- N (2) 2" x 6-1/4" rectangles

Fabric 4 Red

From the fat quarter cut:

- O (2) 5-3/4" x 12" rectangles

Fabric 5 Pink

From the fat quarter cut:

- P (4) 3" squares
- Q (4) 2-1/2" squares
- R (2) 2-1/2" x 2" rectangles
- S (1) 2" x 13-1/2" rectangle
- T (1) 2" x 9-1/2" rectangle

Binding

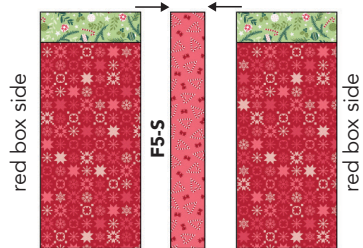
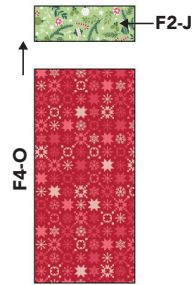
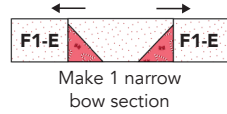
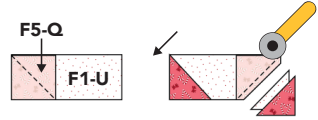
Cut (4) 2-1/4" x WOF strips.

Simple Gifts Table Runner Instructions

Please read all instructions before you begin. Seam allowance is 1/4". Fabric is abbreviated as by number. For example, Fabric 1 is 'F1'. Press in the direction of the arrows.

Make the Red Gift Block

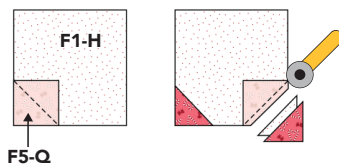
1. Mark diagonal lines on the F5-Q 2-1/2" squares.
2. Place an F5-Q square, right sides facing, on the left side of an F1-U rectangle and sew on the diagonal line. Trim, leaving 1/4". Press toward F5.
3. Repeat on the opposite corner of the F1-U rectangle. Make 1.
4. Sew an F1-E rectangle to both sides of the step 3 unit. Press away from center. Make 1 bow unit.
5. Sew an F2-J rectangle to the top of an F4-O rectangle. Press toward F2. Make 2 box side units.
6. Sew a red box side unit to either side of a F5-S rectangle. Press toward F5. Make 1.
7. Sew the step 4 bow unit to the top of the step 6 unit. Press. The Red Gift Block should measure 12-1/2" x 15-1/2".

Make the Green Gift Block

1. Place an F5-Q 2-1/2" square to the lower left corner of an F1-H 6-1/2" square and sew on the diagonal line. Trim, leaving 1/4". Press toward F5.

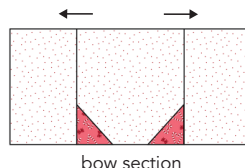


2. Repeat on the opposite corner of the F1-H square. Make 1.

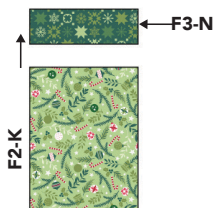


3. Sew an F1-G rectangle to either side of the step 2 unit. Press away from center. Make 1 bow unit.

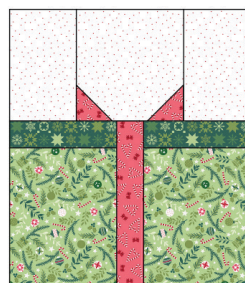
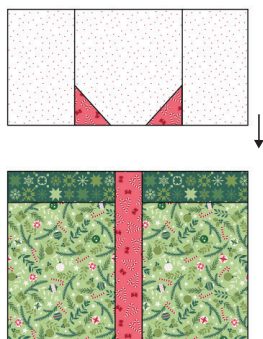
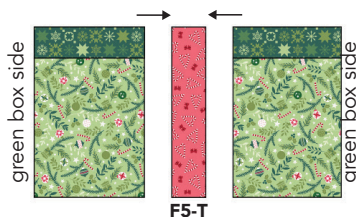
4. Sew an F3-N rectangle to the top of an F2-K rectangle. Press toward F3. Make 2 green box side units.



5. Sew a green box side unit to either side of an F5-T rectangle. Press toward F5. Make 1.



Make 2 green box sides



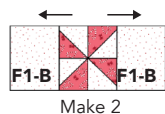
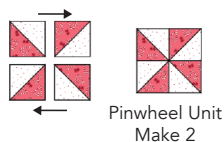

Make the Tree Blocks

Half Square Triangles (HST units)

1. Mark diagonal lines on the F1-D squares. Place the F1-D squares, right sides together, over the F5-P squares. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on either side of the marked line. Cut on the marked line. Press. Make 4 pairs for a total of 8 HST units.

F1-D & F5-P

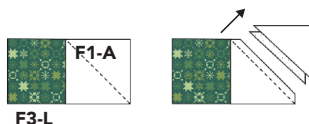


2. Lay out the units as illustrated to the right. Sew the HSTs together to make the pinwheel unit. Press. Make 2.

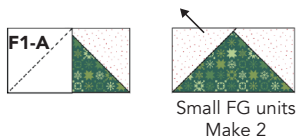
3. Sew an F1-B rectangle on either side of the step 2 unit. Press. Make 2.

Flying Geese (FG units)

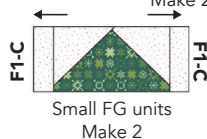
1. Mark a diagonal line on the F1-A squares. Place an F1-A square, right sides together, over an F3-L rectangle. Sew on the marked line. Cut $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the sewn line. Press.



2. Repeat step 1 on the opposite side of the step 1 unit. Make 2 small FG units.

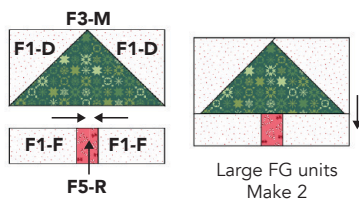


3. Sew an F1-C rectangle to either side of the small step 3 FG units. Press. Make 2.



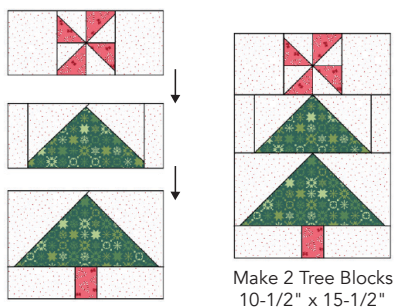
4. Repeat the same process to make the large FG units, using F1-D squares and F3-M rectangles.

5. Sew an F1-E rectangle to opposite sides of a F5-R rectangle. Press. Make 2.



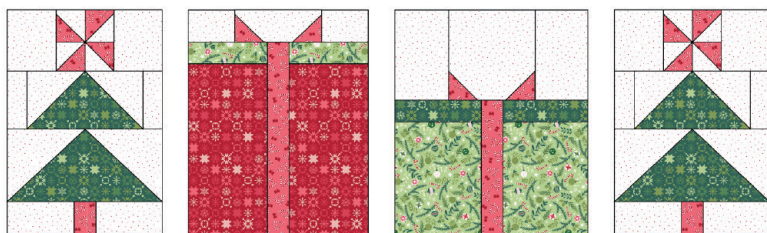
6. Sew the step 5 units to bottom of the large FG units.

7. Lay the sections out into rows as illustrated to the right. Sew row to row. Press. Make 2. The Tree Blocks should measure $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x $15\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Top Assembly

1. Lay the blocks out as illustrated below and sew together. Press.
2. Sew the F1 2" x 45-1/2" sashing to the top and bottom of the blocks. Press.
3. Sew the F1 2" x 18-1/2" side sashing to the sides of the runner top. Press.

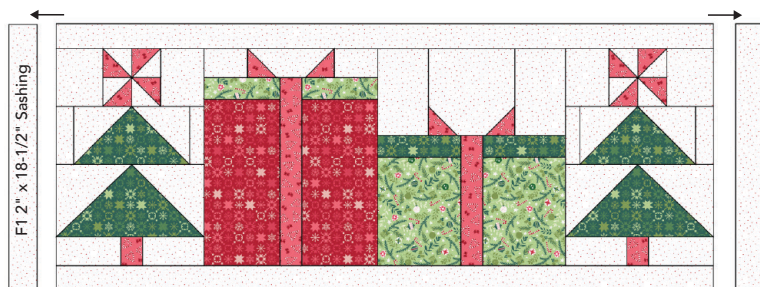
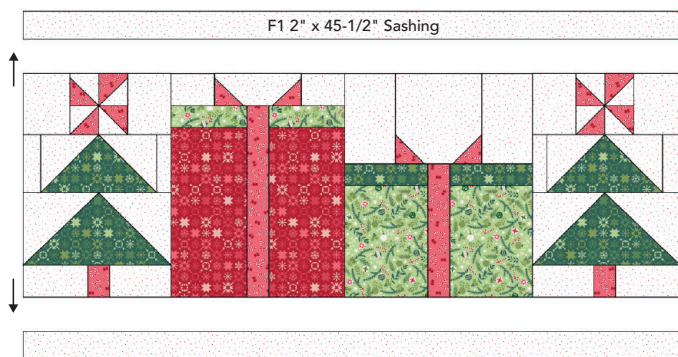


Tree Block

Finishing

1. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting and runner top (right side up). Baste layers to secure. Quilt as desired. Trim the excess backing and batting.
2. Sew the binding strips together into one continuous strip. Press in half length-wise. Sew the binding to the runner top with a 1/4" seam allowance. Turn the binding to the back side of the runner and stitch down by hand with matching thread.
