Cutting

Finished size: 60 x 75

Fabrics 1 & 3

Cut (3) 3-1/2" x WOF strips into:

(32) A 3-1/2" squares

Cut (1) 6-1/2" x WOF strip into:

(4) D 6-1/2" squares

Fabrics 2 & 4

Cut (3) 3-1/2" x WOF strips into:

(16) A 3-1/2" squares

(8) B 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles

(4) C 3-1/2" squares

Fabrics 5, 7, 9, & 11

Cut (2) 3-1/2" x WOF strips into:

(24) A 3-1/2" squares

Cut (1) 6-1/2" x WOF strip into:

(3) D 6-1/2" squares

Fabrics 6, 8, 10, & 12

Cut (3) 3-1/2" x WOF strips into:

(12) A 3-1/2" squares

(6) B 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles

(3) C 3-1/2" squares

Background Fabric: BG

Cut (10) 6-1/2" x WOF strips into:

(120) B 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles

Cut (7) 3-1/2" x WOF strips into:

(80) C 3-1/2" squares

Binding Fabric

Cut (7) 2-1/2" x WOF strips

WOF - Width of Fabric

LOF - Length of Fabric

RST - Right Sides Together

HST - Half Square Triangle

Shadow Stars Quilt Instructions

Please read all instructions before you begin. Seam allowance is 1/4". Fabric is abbreviated as 'F' - for example, F1 refers to Fabric 1. BG refers to Background Fabric. Press all seams open.

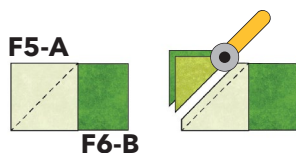
Flying Geese Units

1. Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of all the A squares.

2. Place an F5-A square, RST over an F6-B rectangle. Sew on the marked line.

3. Cut 1/4" away from the sewn line. Press open.

4. Repeat Steps 2-3 on the opposite corner. Trim to finish at 3-1/2" x 6-1/2". Make 6.

5. Repeat Steps 2-4 using the combinations illustrated to the right. Pay attention to whether you will make 6 or 8 of each fabric combination.

Shadow Star Blocks

1. Sew a background BG-C square to the left of an F5/F6 flying geese unit and an F6-C square to the right. Press open.



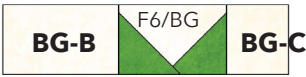
Step 1 unit:
Make 1

2. Sew a background BG-C square to either side of an F5/BG flying geese unit. Press open.



Step 2 unit:
Make 1

3. Sew a background BG-B rectangle to the left side of an F6/BG flying geese unit and a background BG-C square to the right side. Press open.



Step 3 unit: Make 1

4. Sew a background BG-B rectangle to the right side of an F6/BG flying geese unit. Press open.



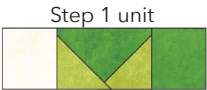
Step 4 unit: Make 1

5. Sew an F5/BG flying geese unit to the left side of an F5-D square. Press open.

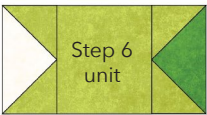


Step 6 unit: Make 1

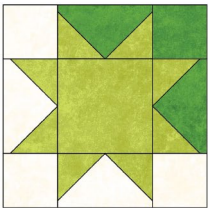
7. Sew the Step 1 unit to the top of the Step 6 unit. Press open.



8. Sew the Step 2 unit to the bottom of the Step 7 unit. Press open.



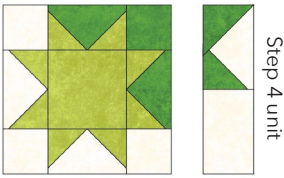

Inner Star

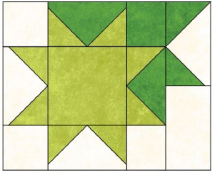

9. Sew the Step 4 unit to the right side of the Step 8 inner star. Press open.

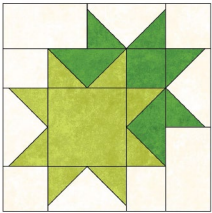


Inner Star

10. Sew the Step 3 unit to the top of the Step 9 unit. Press open. The Shadow Star block measures 15-1/2" square.



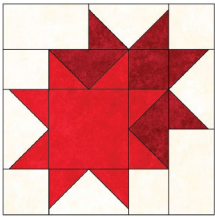

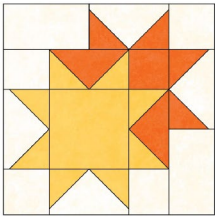
F5-F6 Make 3

11. Repeat Steps 1-10 to make a total of (3) F5/F6 Shadow Star blocks.

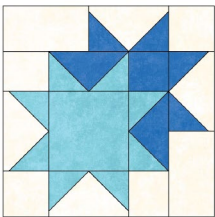
12. Repeat Steps 1-10 to make the other Shadow Star fabric combinations shown below.



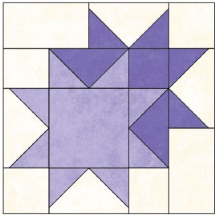

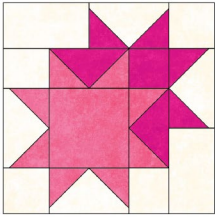

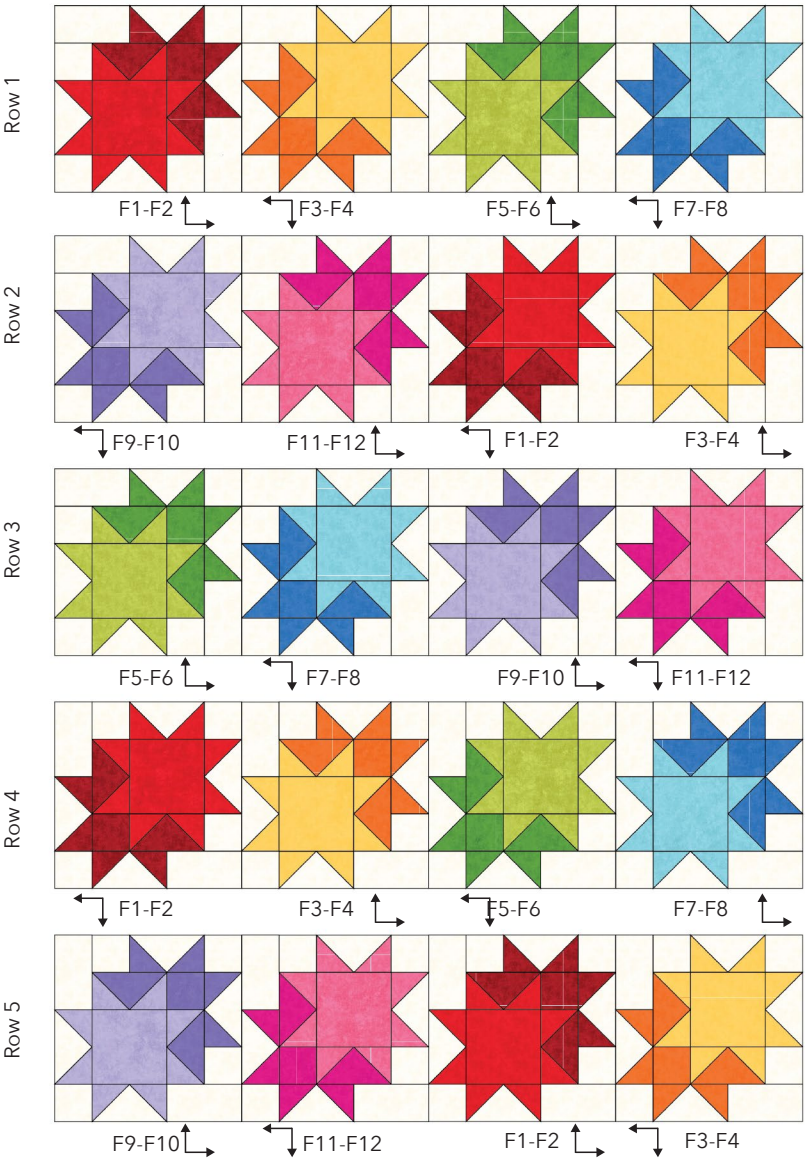

Sew the Rows

Note: The stars either have the shadow sections in the upper right or lower left, depending on the row. Make sure to refer to the arrows on the diagram when you are sewing the rows. Shadow in the upper right. Shadow in the lower left

- 1 Arrange the blocks into 5 rows as illustrated below, rotating the position of the stars.
- 2. Sew the blocks into rows and then sew row to row.



Finishing

1. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting and quilt top (right side up). Baste layers to secure. Quilt as desired. Trim the excess backing and batting.

2. Sew the binding strips together into one continuous strip. Press in half length-wise. Sew the binding to the quilt top with a 1/4" seam allowance, 3/8" if using flannel for the binding. Turn the binding to the back side of the quilt and stitch down by hand with matching thread.
