

WOF - Width of Fabric

Finished size: 52-1/2" x 66"	
Fabric 1	Fussy cut (12) 5" x 5" wreaths
Fabric 2 Dark Green Words	Cut (5) 2-3/4" x WOF strips into: A: (24) 2-3/4" x 2-3/4" squares B: (24) 2-3/4" x 5" rectangles
Binding	Cut (6) 2-1/4" x WOF strips.
Fabric 3 Medium Green Texture	Cut (7) 2-3/4" x WOF strips into: C: (48) 2-3/4" x 2-3/4" squares D: (24) 2-3/4" x 5" rectangles Cut (5) 2" x WOF strips. Sew end to end. Cut into: (2) 2" x 43-1/2" inner top/bottom borders (2) 2" x 54-1/2" inner side borders
Fabric 4 Light Green Tossed	Cut (8) 2-3/4 x WOF strips into: E: (72) 2-3/4" x 2-3/4" squares F: (24) 2-3/4" x 5" rectangles
Fabric 5 Red Tossed	Cut (6) 2-3/4 x WOF strips into: G: (48) 2-3/4" x 5" rectangles
Fabric 6 Tan Dots	Cut (11) 2-3/4" x WOF strips into: H: (120) 2-3/4" x 2-3/4" squares I: (24) 2-3/4" x 5" rectangles
Fabric 7 Red Check	Cut (2) 2-3/4 x WOF strips into: J: (24) 2-3/4" x 2-3/4" squares
Fabric 8 Tan Stars	Cut (6) 5" x WOF strips. Sew end to end. Cut into: (2) 5" x 53" outer top/bottom borders (2) 5" x 57-1/2" outer side borders

Charming Stars Quilt Instructions

Please read all instructions before you begin. Seam allowance is 1/4". Fabric is abbreviated as 'F' - for example, F1 refers to Fabric 1. Press in the direction of the arrows.

Green Wreath Blocks

Flying Geese

1. Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on an F3-C square. Place on the left corner of an F2-B rectangle. Sew on the marked line. Trim 1/4" away from the stitched line, press.






2. Repeat step one on the opposite side. Press. Make 24.

Center Star Units

3. Sew flying geese units to opposite sides of a fussy-cut wreath square, press. Make 6.

4. Sew an F2-A square to either side of (12) flying geese, press.


5. Sew a step 4 unit to the top and bottom of the step 3 unit, press. Make 6.





Green Wreath Blocks (continued)


6. Repeat steps 1-2 to make (24) F3-D/
F4-E flying geese.



7. Sew an F4-E square to either side of
(12) flying geese, press.





8. Sew an F4-F rectangle to either side of
(12) flying geese, press.



9. Sew the step 7 units to opposite sides
of each center star unit, press.

10. Sew the step 8 units to the top and
bottom of each step 9 unit, press.
Make 6.

Red Wreath Blocks

Center Star Units

11. Repeat steps 1-2 to make (48) F5-G/F6-H flying geese.

12. Sew flying geese units to opposite sides of a fussy-cut wreath square, press. Make 6.

13. Sew an F7-J square to either side of (12) flying geese, press.


14. Sew a step 13 unit to the top and bottom of the step 12 unit, press. Make 6.

15. Sew an F6-H square to either side of (12) flying geese, press.

16. Sew an F6-I rectangle to either side of (12) flying geese, press.

17. Sew the step 15 units to opposite sides of the center star unit.


18. Sew the step 16 units to the top and bottom of the step 17 units, press. Make 6.



Sew the Rows and Borders

Follow the illustration on p.7

1 Lay the blocks out for the quilt top, alternating the green and red wreath blocks.

2. Sew the blocks into rows, press in opposite directions to nest.

3. Sew row to row. Press open.

4. Sew the inside side borders to the quilt top.

Press. Then sew the inside top and bottom borders to the quilt top. Press.

5. Sew the inside side borders to the quilt top. Press. Then sew the inside top and bottom borders to the quilt top. Press.


Sew the Borders

Sewing Borders Tip: Pin the borders onto the quilt top starting with one pin in the center and one at each end. Then add pins in between. Do not pin from one end to the other. Press toward the borders.


Top Border 5" X 53"

Side Borders 5" X 57-1/2"



Finishing

1. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting and quilt top (right side up). Baste layers to secure. Quilt as desired. Trim the excess backing and batting.
2. Sew the binding strips together into one continuous strip. Press in half length-wise. Sew the binding to the quilt top with a 1/4" seam allowance. Turn the binding to the back side of the quilt and stitch down by hand with matching thread.
