WRAP PARTY Quilt Instructions

Please read all instructions before you begin.

Seam allowance is 1/4" unless otherwise stated.

Fabric will be abbreviated to 'F'.
For example, F11 refers to Fabric 11.

Cutting

Finished Size 66" x 76"

Fabrics 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8

A: From each fat quarter cut:
(3) 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles

Fabric 8

A: From the fat quarter cut:
(4) 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles

Fabric 9

A: From the 1/2 yard cut:
(6) 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles

Fabric 11

Cut (8) 1-1/2" x WOF Strips
Subcut into
B: (30) 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles

Binding

Cut (8) 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Fabric 12

Cut (8) 1-1/2" x WOF Strips
Subcut into
C: (30) 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles.

Fabric 13

Cut (8) 2" x WOF Strips
Subcut into
D: (30) 2" x 10-1/2" rectangles.

Fabric 14

Cut (8) 2" x WOF Strips
Subcut into
E: (30) 2" x 10-1/2" rectangles.

Fabric 15

Cut (6) 2-1/2" x WOF strips.
Piece into the inner borders
(2) 2-1/2" x 54-1/2"
(2) 2-1/2" x 60-1/2"

Fabric 16

Cut (7) 6-1/2" x WOF strips
Piece into the outer border
(2) 6-1/2" x 64-1/2"
(2) 6-1/2" x 66-1/2"

WOF - Width of Fabric


LOF - Length of Fabric

RST - Right Sides Together


HST - Half Square Triangle

Make the A Blocks

1. Sew a F11-B rectangle to opposite sides of a F1-A rectangle. Press away from center.
2. Sew a F13-D rectangle to opposite sides of the A-B unit. Press away from center. Block finishes at 10-1/2" x 10-1/2". Make 3.




Repeat steps 1 and 2 to make the following A Blocks, sewing the F13-D and F11-B to opposite sides of the A rectangles in Fabrics 2, 3 and 9. NOTE: Make 6 blocks in Fabric 9.




Make the B Blocks

1. Sew a F12-C rectangle to opposite sides of a F4-A rectangle. Press away from center.
2. Sew a F14-E rectangle to opposite sides of the C/A/C unit. Press away from center. Block finishes at 10-1/2" x 10-1/2". Make 3.




Repeat steps 1 and 2 to make the following B Blocks, sewing the F12-C and F14-E rectangles to opposite sides of the A rectangles in Fabrics 5, 6, 7, and 8. NOTE: Make 4 blocks in Fabric 8.



Assemble the Quilt Center:

Lay the blocks out in rows of 5. Alternate the A and B blocks as illustrated below. Sew the blocks into rows. Press each row in the opposite direction to nest the seams. Sew row to row. Press in one direction. Quilt center will measure 50-1/2" x 60-1/2".



Borders

1. Sew the F15 60-1/2" inner border strips to the sides of the quilt center. Press away from center.
2. Sew the F15 54-1/2" inner border strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press away from center.
3. Sew the F16 64-1/2" outer border strips to the sides of the quilt. Press toward center.
4. Sew the F16 66-1/2" outer border strips to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press toward center.



Finishing

1. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting and quilt top (right side up). Baste layers together to secure. Quilt as desired. Trim the excess backing and batting.
2. Sew the F11 binding strips together into one continuous strip. Press in half length-wise. Sew the binding to the quilt top with a 3/8" seam allowance, mitering the corners. Turn the binding to the back side of the quilt and stitch down by hand with matching thread.
